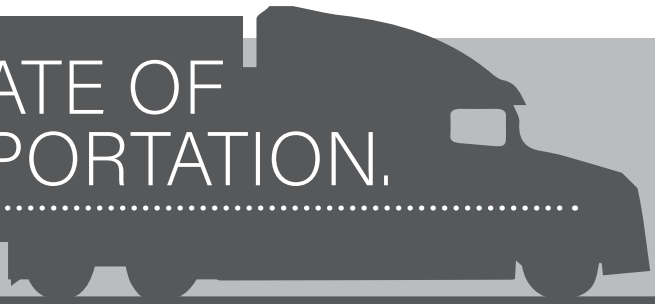



1. Speeding
2. Distraction
3. Failure to yield right of way
4. Impairment
5. Vision obscured
6. Careless driving
7. Failure to keep in proper lane
8. Failure to obey traffic sign
9. Following improperly
10. Overcorrecting
